

ORDINANCE AMENDMENT NO. 26-03

“AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE VI PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT: CHAPTER 5 UTILITIES – BILLING CHARGES: 6-5-5 DISCONTINUING SERVICE, FEES.”

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDER, IOWA:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Ordinance is to add Title VI Physical Environment Chapter 5 – Utilities – Billing Charges, Section 6-5-5 Discontinuing Service, Fees (7.) to the Alexander Code of Ordinances 2025.

Section 2. Amendment to Title VI Physical Environment Chapter 5 – Utilities – Billing Charges, Section 6-5-5 Discontinuing Service, Fees of the Alexander Code of Ordinances 2025. Number 7, to read as follows:

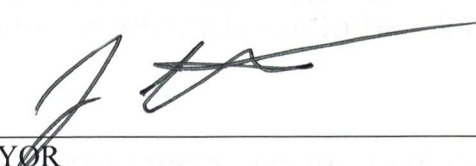
6-5-5 DISCONTINUING SERVICE, FEES.

7. A property owner may request water service be temporarily discontinued and shut off at the curb valve when the property is expected to be vacant for an extended period of time. There shall be a \$100.00 fee collected for shutting the water off at the curb valve and a \$100.00 fee for restoring service. During a period when service is temporarily discontinued as provided herein there shall be no minimum service charge.

Section 3. Severability Clause. If any provision or part of this Ordinance be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part hereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

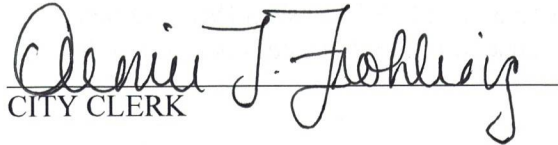
Section 4. When Effective: This Ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
